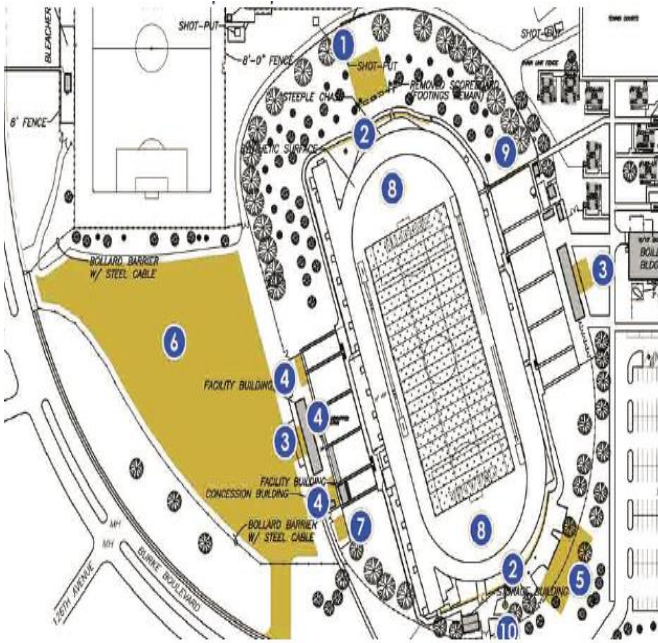


## Historical:

- Hosted hundreds of Burke High School classes, football, track, soccer, lacrosse games and practices
- Used by area clubs, elementary and middle schools.
- Current home field of Creighton Prep High School football
- Hosted thousands of community youth team games and practices
- Hosted numerous local, regional and national track and field meets
- Hosted numerous Metro and State championship events
- Hosted a variety of school and community events
  - From graduations and church services to concerts
- Burke Stadium boasts a state of art track surface and electronics
- Burke Stadium boasts state of the art field turf sports field
- Burke's Video Board is the largest video board in a high school in the country
  - Allowing for real time results, video and replay of events
  - Burke students assist in video production service

## Nebraska State High School Boys and Girls Track and Field Championships

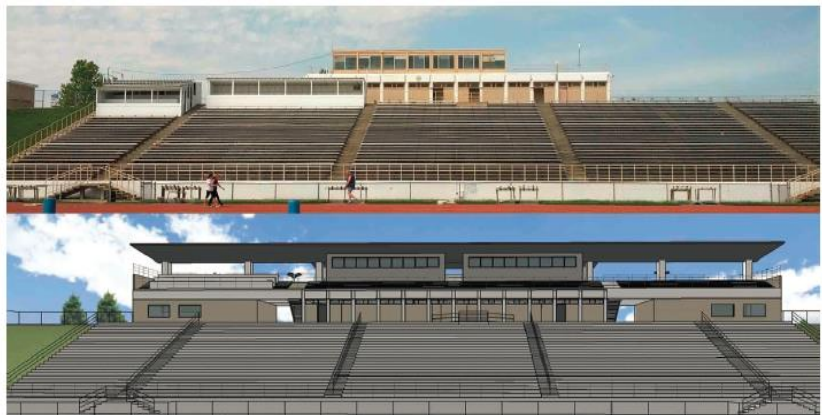
- Has been held at Burke since 1971 - 43 continuously years
- 3,500 High School Student Athletes from schools throughout the state must earn the right to compete at Burke Stadium annually
- 28,000 family, friends and fans attend to cheer on their kids in this 2 day event
- 20,000 - Athletes, Coaches, Family, Friends and Fans crowd into Burke Stadium on Saturday's finals to take part in this traditional event
- Ranking Nebraska 3rd nationally in attendance for a High School Track and Field Championship



## Stadium Renovation Plans Include:

- Bringing stadium into code compliance
- Increase bleacher seating by approximately 600 seats
- Meet participant and spectator needs
- Improve fan experience
- Improve event traffic flow
- Decrease dust issues
- Increase bank seating
- Increase ability to generate income
- Meet electronic needs
- Safety and security improvements
- Improve local community relations
- Improve function as classroom space
- Showcase and share the accomplishments of kids

Renovation of Burke's Stadium will prepare OPS/Burke to host local, state and national events for the next 50 years



## Zone 1: Interior Fence and Stairwell Renovation

- Replacement of all dead and dying trees
- Replacement of fence on north and south end
- Install brick columns with tribute plaques
- Fence column donor recognition
- Replacement of N/E team stairs
- Address drainage issues
- Install Burke stadium signature piece
- South entrance field name
- South flag pole base donor recognition



## Zone 2: West & East Stadiums and Press Box Renovation

### West Stadium -

- Removal of west "temporary" press boxes
- Built in the '70's
- Renovate / expand restrooms
- Install 2 concession stands



### Press Box Renovation

- Move Press area to 2nd level
- Covered Area on second level
- Create 200 "Club Level" Seats
- Update all electronic / electrical needs

### East Stadium -

- Renovate / expand restrooms
- Install 2 concession stands



### West Parking Lot Renovation

- Pave
- Installation of new exit / entrance

### Field House - 5,680 sf

- Restrooms available at field level
- Open concept multi-purpose area
- Event hospitality area
- Team / pre-game meeting area
- Classroom

- Covered Deck - 3600 sf

- multipurpose space
